

ORDINANCE #2013-1128

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE #1074 ENTITLED
“AN ORDINANCE TO REPLACE THE RECREATION COMMISSION
AND ESTABLISH A RECREATION DEPARTMENT AND COMMITTEE
WITHIN THE BOROUGH OF MANVILLE”**

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

The purpose of this ordinance is to amend Ordinance #1074 to add Sections 11 and 12: Behavior Policy and Inclusion Policy.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Manville in the County of Somerset and State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 11. BEHAVIOIR POLICY FOR RECREATIONAL PROGRAMMING

Program participants, parents, coaches and spectators are expected to exhibit appropriate and acceptable behavior at all times to ensure that Borough recreation programs are safe and enjoyable for all. Participants, parents, coaches and spectators are expected to:

- remain within the specific program area
- respect the staff, coaches, volunteers, other participants, equipment and facilities
- adhere to all facility rules
- refrain from using inappropriate language or gestures
- refrain from deliberate or intentional hitting or touching

Participants, parents, coaches and spectators who choose not to accept the above responsibilities are subject to disciplinary action which may include:

- verbal warning
- time-out from the activity
- exemption from the activity
- parent conference with staff, coach or volunteer
- suspension from the program and/or trip
- expulsion from the program

Disciplinary action may vary depending on the frequency, severity and nature of the behavior and will be accompanied by a report to be discussed with and signed by the parent. Additional rules may be developed for particular programs and leagues as deemed necessary by the Recreation Department.

No refunds will be administered if a child is dismissed from a program for violation of the behavior policy.

SECTION 12. INCLUSION POLICY

The Borough of Manville welcomes everyone to participate in its programs and facilities regardless of race, color, gender, disability, age, sexual orientation, national origin, or religious or political affiliation. If you have individualized needs due to a disability, please contact the Manville Recreation Department on (908) 725-9478 and we will gladly arrange reasonable accommodations for participation in our programming. Three (3) weeks' notice is required to ensure that appropriate accommodations can be provided.

The Borough of Manville does not discriminate on the basis of disability in the admission or access to, or treatment or employment in its programs and activities. The Borough of Manville Administrator having an office at 325 North Main Street, Manville, NJ has been designated to coordinate compliance with the nondiscrimination requirements contained in section 35.107 of the Department of Justice regulations. Information concerning the provisions of the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA), and the rights provided thereunder, is available from the Borough Administrator.

SECTION 13. CONSTRUCTION

Where consistent with the context in which used in this ordinance, words importing the singular shall include the plural; words importing the plural shall include the singular; and words importing one gender shall include all other genders.

SECTION 14. INCONSISTENCY

Should any provision of this ordinance be inconsistent with the provisions of any prior ordinances, the inconsistent provisions of said prior ordinances are hereby repealed, but only to the extent of such inconsistencies.

SECTION 15. SEVERABILITY

In the event that any provision of this ordinance, or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is declared invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such declaration of invalidity shall not affect any other provision or application of this ordinance which may be given effect and, to realize this intent, the provisions and applications of this ordinance are declared to be severable.

SECTION 16. PURPOSE OF CAPTIONS

Captions contained in this ordinance have been inserted only for the purpose of facilitating reference to the various sections, and are not intended and shall not be utilized to construe the intent and meaning of the text of any section.

SECTION 17. EFFECTIVE DATE

This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final adoption and approval of the same in accordance with the laws of the State of New Jersey.


