

Ordinance #2002-971

“AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 500 ENTITLED  
‘AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE MOTOR VEHICLE PARKING  
AND TRAFFIC IN THE STREETS AND PARKING LOTS OF  
THE BOROUGH OF MANVILLE, AND PROVIDING PENALTIES  
FOR THE VIOLATIONS THEREOF.’”

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Manville in the County  
of  
Somerset and State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION I.

Article III. Limiting the use of streets to a certain class of vehicles, is amended to read:

SECTION 3-1 Trucks over (4) four tons **registered gross vehicle weight**  
excluded from certain streets.

Trucks over (4) four tons **registered gross vehicle weight** are hereby excluded  
from the streets of parts of streets described in Schedule V except for the pick-up and  
delivery of materials on such streets. Said Schedule V being attached to and made a  
part of this Ordinance.

SECTION II.

Schedule V is hereby amended to read:

SCHEDULE V. TRUCKS OVER FOUR (4) TONS REGISTERED GROSS VEHICLE  
WEIGHT EXCLUDED

In accordance with the provisions of Article III, Section 3-1, trucks over four (4)  
tons **registered gross vehicle weight** are hereby excluded from the following streets,  
except for the pick-up and delivery of materials on any such street:

Brooks Boulevard

North Main Street to the Manville  
Borough Western boundary line

SECTION III.

This Ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication according to law.
