

Ordinance #2001-962

AN ORDINANCE MAKING THE PROVISIONS OF SUBTITLE ONE OF TITLE 39, CONTAINING VARIOUS TRAFFIC REGULATIONS, APPLICABLE TO THE ADESA AUTO AUCTIONS SITE, AND REGULATING THE USE OF SAID ROADWAYS, STREETS, DRIVEWAYS AND PARKING LOTS BY MOTOR VEHICLES

WHEREAS, Adesa Auction of New Jersey has filed a written consent with the borough of Manville to make the provisions of Subtitle One, Title 39, of the Revised Statutes of the State of New Jersey, applicable to the semi-private roads, streets, driveways and parking lots at the Adesa Auction site located in the Borough of Manville, County of Somerset;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Manville, in the County of Somerset and State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1. ADOPTION OF REGULATIONS.

The following Regulations shall be enforceable in and upon the semi-private roads, streets, driveways and parking lots of the Adesa Auction site located in the Borough of Manville, County of Somerset:

“REGULATIONS:

1. General Parking:

- A. All vehicles must park in designated areas and between the lines provided.
- B. No person shall stop or stand a vehicle upon any of the streets described below, except in areas covered by other parking restrictions.

1. All Roads and Aisles	Both	All	Entire Length

C. Handicapped Parking:

All stalls shall be 12 feet wide as shown on the attached site plan and signed with the R7-8 and R7-8P (Reserved Parking Sign and Penalty Plate) in the designated parking areas for persons who have been issued the Handicapped Parking Permits by the Division of Motor Vehicles.

D. Overnight Parking Prohibitions:

No person shall park a vehicle overnight upon any of the roads or lots on the entire property.

E. Reserved Parking:

All vehicles that are granted specialty parking in this section such as: police vehicles, ambulances, teachers, etc., must be properly identified and the reserved parking spaces must be shown on the attached site plan.

2. Through Streets and Stop Intersections:

A. Through Streets:

The following streets or parts of streets are hereby designated as Through Streets. Stop signs shall be installed on the near right side of each street intersecting the Through Street except where Yield signs are provided for in the designation.

<u>Name of Street</u>	<u>Limits</u>
1. Road "B"	Entire Length
2. Road "D"	Entire Length
3. Road "E"	Entire Length
4. Road "F"	Entire Length

B. Stop Intersections:

The following described intersections are hereby designated as Stop Intersections. Stop Signs shall be installed as provided herein.

<u>Intersection</u>	<u>Stop Sign(s) on:</u>
1. Road "A" and Road "B"	Road "B"
2. Road "F" and Aisle "F"	Road "F"
3. Main Drive and Road "B"	Road "B"

3. Speed Limits:

- A. The speed limit for both directions of traffic in the parking lot(s) shall be 15 M.P.H.

B. The speed limit for both directions of travel on the following roadways are:

<u>Name of Roadway</u>	<u>M.P.H.</u>	<u>Limits</u>
1. Road "A"	25	Entire Length
2. Main Road	25	Entire Length
3. All Other Roads	15	Entire Length

4. Tow-Away zones:

Any vehicle parked or standing as to obstruct or impede a normal flow of traffic, block entrances or exit ways, loading zones, oil fills, any grassy area, pedestrian walkway, or present in any way a safety or traffic hazard may be removed by towing the vehicle at the owner's or operator's expense.

5. Loading Zone(s):

The locations described are hereby designated as Loading Zones. No person shall park a vehicle in said location during the times indicated other than for the loading or unloading of goods and materials.

<u>Name of Street</u>	<u>Time</u>	<u>Location</u>
1. Aisle "G"	All	As indicated on site plan"

SECTION 2. REQUIREMENTS FOR SIGNING.

That all signs, posts, or other necessary materials be installed and paid for by the applicant. All signing shall conform to the current Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices, pursuant to *N.J.S.A. 39:4-198* and *N.J.S.A. 39:4-183.27*.

SECTION 3. PENALTY.

Any person convicted of violation of any provision of this ordinance shall be subject to such penalty as shall be expressly provided by New Jersey statute, or in the absence of any such specified penalty, a penalty in accordance with Ordinance No. 97-887.

SECTION 4. CONSTRUCTION.

Where consistent with the context in which used in this ordinance, words importing the singular shall include the plural; words importing the plural shall include the singular; and, words importing one gender shall include all other genders.

SECTION 5. INCONSISTENCY.

Should any provision of this ordinance be inconsistent with the provisions of any prior ordinances, the inconsistent provisions of said prior ordinances are hereby repealed, but only to the extent of such inconsistencies.

SECTION 6. SEVERABILITY.

In the event that any provision of this ordinance, or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is declared invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such declaration of invalidity shall not affect any other provision or application of this ordinance which may be given effect, and to realize this intent, the provisions and applications of this ordinance are declared to be severable.

SECTION 7. PURPOSE OF CAPTIONS.

Captions contained in this ordinance have been inserted only for the purpose of facilitating reference to the various sections, and are not intended and shall not be utilized to construe the intent and meaning of the text of any section.

SECTION 8. EFFECTIVE DATE.

This ordinance shall be effective immediately upon final adoption, approval and publication in accordance with law.
