STAY CONNECTED.

HURRICANE SEASON starts in June and runs through November. The peak months are August through October. Historically we can clearly see the peak months are when Manville is most affected and when we should be on high alert with the storms that pass through. That's not to suggest panicking with a heavy rain fall but to be mindful and attentive to local forecast reports and emergency broadcasts.

Our first responders are our life lines when we are, literally, in over our heads. We remind you that they work to the absolute best of their ability with the resources they are provided. We are neighbors, friends, and flood victims too. We are all on the same team and aim to keep our residents safe.



Remember, 9-1-1 is for life threatening emergencies. If you are not in immediate danger and do not require emergency assistance you should contact the non-emergency police department's phone number 908-725-1900.

STAY INFORMED.

BEFORE

-Know your emergency evacuation routes and destinations (shelter, family, hotel, etc.). *The vacant lot off of South Main St. and E Camplain Rd. is the designated lot for vehicles for disaster parking only.*

-*The VFW, located at 600 Washington Ave., is the town's Red Cross emergency shelter, only when activated by OEM.*

-Check your emergency kit for necessities especially medications or medical supplies.

-Fill plastic bottles with clean water for drinking.

-Fill your car with fuel in case of evacuation or generator needs.

-Turn off all propane tanks to reduce the risk of fire.

-Secure all outdoor furniture to reduce damage and debris.

-Move valuables and furniture to higher ground if possible.

DURING

-DO NOT WALK, SWIM, OR DRIVE through flood waters!

-Avoid contact with flood waters due to possible contamination.

-Stay informed of the current weather



STAY PREPARED.

conditions and situation updates via local radio (Manville's AM1690), TV, NOAA, or SMART911.

- Monitor forecasted rainfall <https://www.wpc.ncep.noaa.gov/#page=qpf>.

AFTER

-If any utilities have been flooded do not use them until they have been secured or repaired by a professional.

-Take pictures of the damage done to your home. Documentation is very important!

-Wear protective clothing when removing flooded items.

-Gradually and slowly pump the water out of your basement.

-Consult with professionals regarding the rebuilding, repairs, structural integrity, and flood prevention measures for your home.

-Do not hesitate to seek assistance with emotional recovery or stress management. This is a very traumatic experience for you and your loved ones!
