AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE BOARD OF
HEALTH OF THE BOROUGH OF MANVILLE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Borough of Manville:

1. There shall be in and for the Borough of Manville a Board of Health in accordance with the provisions of the act of the Legislature of New Jersey, entitled "An act to establish in this State Boards of Health and a Bureau of Vital Statistics, and to define their respective powers and duties", approved March 31, 1887, and the several supplements thereto.

2. The said Board of Health shall consist of Seven (7) members, and Stephen Wass, Stephen Sargent, Zigmund Irakowski, Casper Impellerzerik, John Tomish, Jr., Michael Waslysyn, and Joseph Stelma.

are hereby appointed to constitute the said Board of Health. Stephen Sargent shall hold Office until Dec. 31st, 1937; Stephen Wass and Zigmund Irakowski and Michael Waslysyn shall hold Office until December 31, 1938; John Tomish and ~~Casper Impellerzerri~~ and Joseph Stelma shall hold office until December 31, 1939.

All members of said Board hereafter appointed shall be appointed by the Council and hold said office for the term of three years, except in the case of vacancies. Vacancies shall be filled for the unexpired term.

3. Said Board of Health shall adopt rules and regulations for its own government, and shall elect a President from among its own members.

all appointees of said Board of Health shall be governed by the rules of said Board, and they may be removed for cause by said Board; the Marshals of said Borough, when on police duty, shall be special sanitary inspectors, and they shall promptly report to the Board of Health every violation of the health ordinances of the Borough which may come within their observation or knowledge.

5. The said Board of Health shall not contract any debt or debts of any kind beyond the amount of the appropriation made for its use by this Council.

All ordinances inconsistent herewith shall be and the same are hereby repealed.

1. 2. The said Board of Health shall consist of five members, and *Dr. Samuel Pogoloff, Charles Krassey, Samuel Weiss, George Kaschak Dr. and Andrew Garella*

are hereby appointed to constitute the said Board of Health. *Charles Krassey* shall hold said office until December 31, 1929; *John T. Weiss and George Kaschak* shall hold said office until December 31, 1930; *Dr. Samuel Pogoloff and Andrew Garella* shall hold office until December 31, 1931. All members of said Board hereafter appointed shall be appointed by the Council and hold said office for the term of three years, except in the case of vacancies. Vacancies shall be filled for the unexpired term.

3. Said Board of Health shall adopt rules and regulations for its own government, and shall elect a President from among its own members.

4. Said Board of Health shall appoint a Registrar of Vital Statistics, Clerk and Sanitary Inspector, and may also appoint such other necessary officers or assistants as said Board of Health may deem necessary; all appointees of said Board of Health shall be governed by the rules of said Board, and they may be removed for cause by said Board; the Marshals of said Borough, when on police duty, shall be special sanitary inspectors, and they shall promptly report to the Board of Health every violation of the health ordinances of the Borough which may come within their observation or knowledge.

5. The said Board of Health shall not contract any debt or debts of any kind beyond the amount of the appropriation made for its use by this Council.
