



**Borough of Manville
Resolution #2024-65**

**Authorizing Addendum to Agreement
Between the Borough of Manville and Manville VFW Post 2290
Re Use of the Manville VFW Building and Facilities
during times of Severe Floods, Hurricanes,
or Other Emergencies or Natural Disasters**

WHEREAS, the past practice of the Borough of Manville and the Thomas J. Kavanaugh Manville VFW Post 2290 (“VFW POST 2290”) has been that during severe floods, hurricanes, and other times of emergency or natural disasters, VFW Post 2290 has allowed the Borough to use the Manville VFW Post 2290 Building located at 600 Washington Ave., Manville, N.J. (“the Manville VFW Building”) for emergency management purposes; and

WHEREAS, in the past the parties agreed in 2015, per the adoption by this governing body of Resolution #2015-106, to enter into an Agreement (the “VFW Shelter Agreement”), which agreement remains in effect as having been renewed by way of Resolution #2023-160, to make upgrades to the electrical system and wiring, including as to the installation of emergency generator switching equipment, at the Manville VFW Building so that said building could continue to effectively serve the community during times of severe floods, hurricanes, or other emergencies or natural disaster; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that it is in the best interest of the Borough of Manville and its taxpayers to enter into an Addendum to said Agreement with VFW POST 2290, rather than for the Borough to incur the far more significant cost involved in acquiring or constructing new facilities, so that the Manville VFW Building can continue to effectively serve the community during times of emergency or natural disasters.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor & Council of the Borough of Manville, in the County of Somerset and State of New Jersey, that the Mayor and Borough Administrator, in consultation with the Borough Engineer, the Borough Attorney, and the Borough Director of Public Works are hereby authorized to prepare and execute an

Addendum to said Agreement, providing for the Borough DPW Department to provide services by way of routine parking lot and pothole repairs, brush removal and landscaping, and snowplowing, so that the Borough can avoid incurring the far more significant cost involved in acquiring or constructing new facilities, and the VFW Building can continue to effectively serve the community during times of severe floods, hurricanes, or other emergencies or natural disasters..
