Authorizing Insertion of Special Item of Revenue in the 2024 Municipal Budget Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:4-87 (Chapter 159, P.L. 1948) – Opioid Settlement Grant

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A:4-87 provides that the Director of the Division of Local Government Services may approve the insertion of any special items of revenue in the budget of any County or Municipality when such item shall have been made by law and the amount thereof was not determined at the time of the adoption of the budget; and

WHEREAS, said Director may also approve the insertion of any item of appropriation for an equal amount.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the Borough of Manville, County of Somerset, New Jersey hereby requests the Director of the Division of Local Government Services to approve the insertion of items of revenue in the current year budget, in the amounts listed below, which item is now available as a revenue:
