ANIMAL LICENSE LETTER

Dear Licensee:

New Jersey state law requires that all dogs over the age of four months be vaccinated against rabies and be licensed through the local animal care and control agency; in this case the Borough of Manville – Clerk's Office. The Borough requires the same provisions and also requires rabies vaccination and licensing for cats.

Licensing is an important means of identification and can help you find your pet if it becomes lost. License revenues are also a vital means of support that helps the Borough promote and protect human and animal safety.

Pet licenses are valid for one (1) year covering the one (1) year period in which your pet's rabies vaccine is valid or three (3) years covering the three (3) years in which your pet's rabies vaccine is valid. All licenses expire January 31st of the renewal year.

STATE LAW requires that in order to issue a license the rabies vaccination must not expire prior to November 1st of the licensing year.

You may license your pet in person or by mail your application and associated fee to the Borough of Manville, Clerk's Office located at 325 North Main Street, Manville, NJ 08835.

How to Get a Pet License

Pet licenses are valid for one year and require the annual submission of an Animal License Form. You may license your pet in person by bringing the completed Animal License Form along with the appropriate fee to the Borough of Manville, Clerk's/Vital Statistics Office located in the Borough of Manville, 325 N. Main Street, Manville, NJ 07060 during normal business hours.

Since the application fee changes annually, please contact the Clerk's Office at (908)448-8446 to ensure the current fees.
