Please be advised the pickup dates for Bulk Trash and Yard Waste have been modified.

The pickup dates for 2016 are:

NOVEMBER	8 <sup>th</sup>	15 <sup>th</sup>

As a reminder, items for pick up are to be placed curbside no earlier than 5 p.m. the evening before and no later than 7 a.m. on the collection day.

Bulk items permitted for collection require the purchase of bulk trash stickers. Stickers can be purchased at the Municipal Complex at 325 North Main Street.

Acceptable Yard Waste should be placed curbside as follows:

- Branches cut to 4 (four) feet in length and tied with twine (no wire or tape).
- Plant Materials or Garden Debris – weeds, leaves, or small brush clippings placed in biodegradable paper bags or in open barrels or cans; with a maximum weight of 35 (thirty-five) pounds per can or bag.
- Items are to be placed neatly curbside; please do not block sidewalks.
- Yard waste loose or in plastic bags will not be collected.
- Grass clipping are not collected curbside.
- Disposal of tree debris done by a private contractor will not be accepted.
